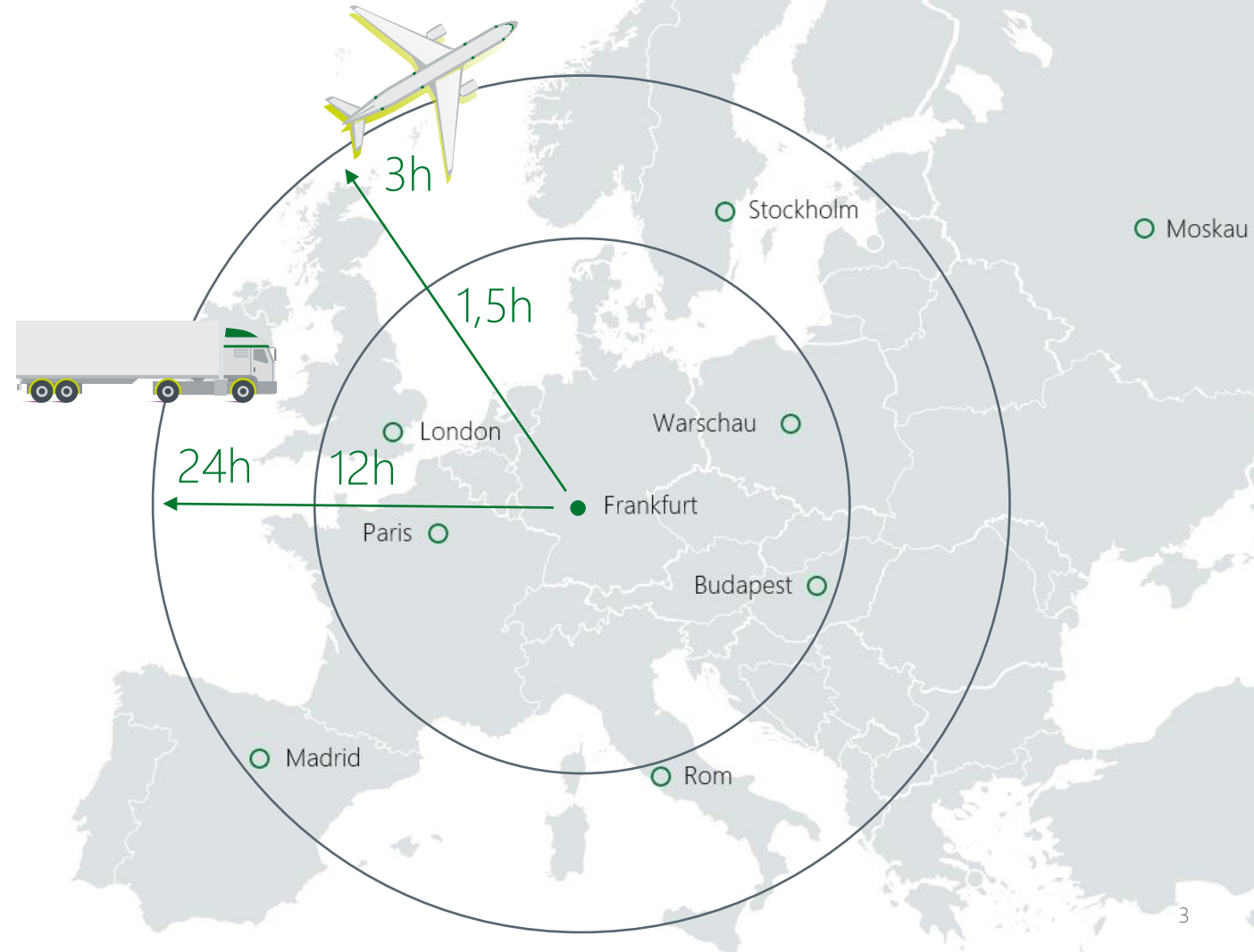
Europe's leading Air Cargo Hub

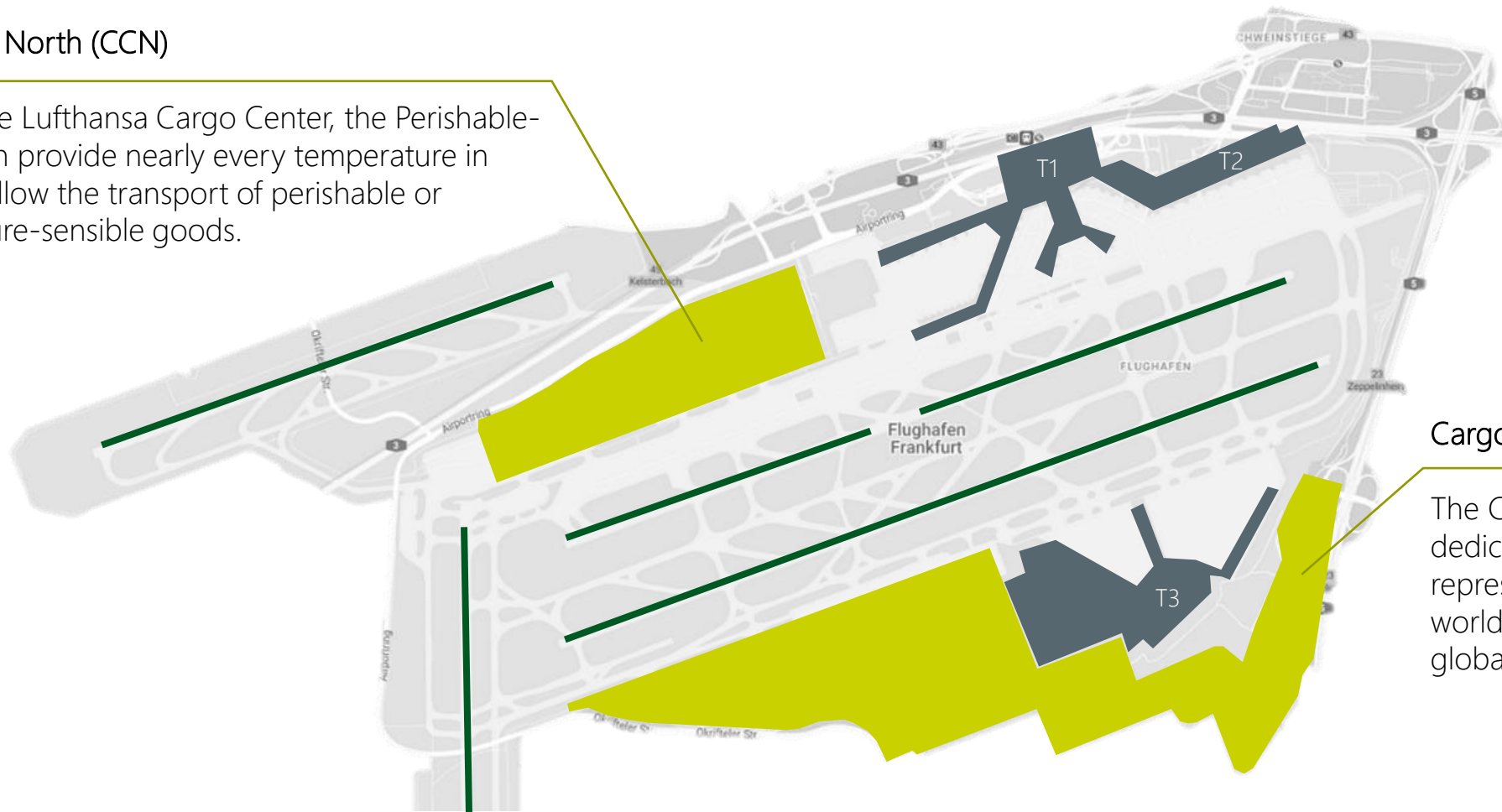

Europe's leading Air Cargo Hub

Frankfurt Airport covers an area of around 22 km². At this area, the largest proportion of Europe's Air Cargo is processed at two dedicated Cargo Cities.

CargoCity North (CCN)

Next to the Lufthansa Cargo Center, the Perishable-Center can provide nearly every temperature in order to allow the transport of perishable or temperature-sensitive goods.



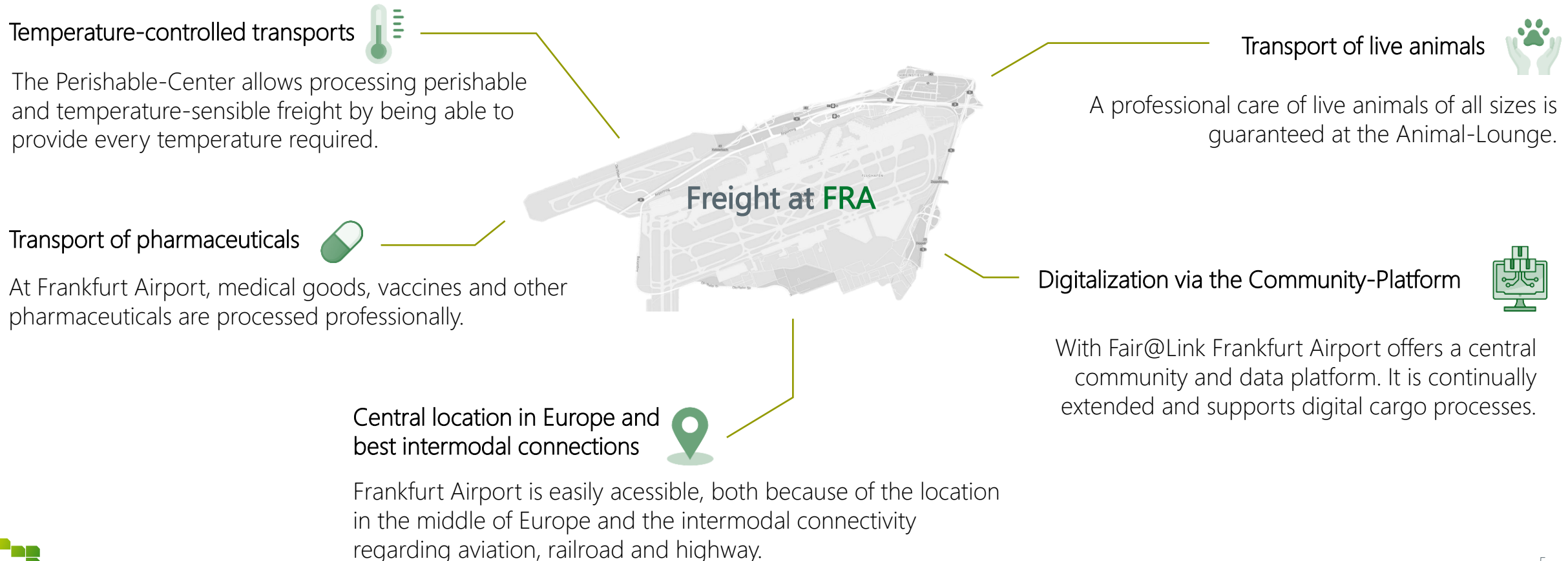
CargoCity South (CCS)

The CargoCity South is mainly dedicated to Air Cargo Handling. It represents the centre of a worldwide distribution network of global logistic player.

Work Through our teams of experts and various events, we create a transparent exchange and initiate concrete projects and measures to promote air freight on site.

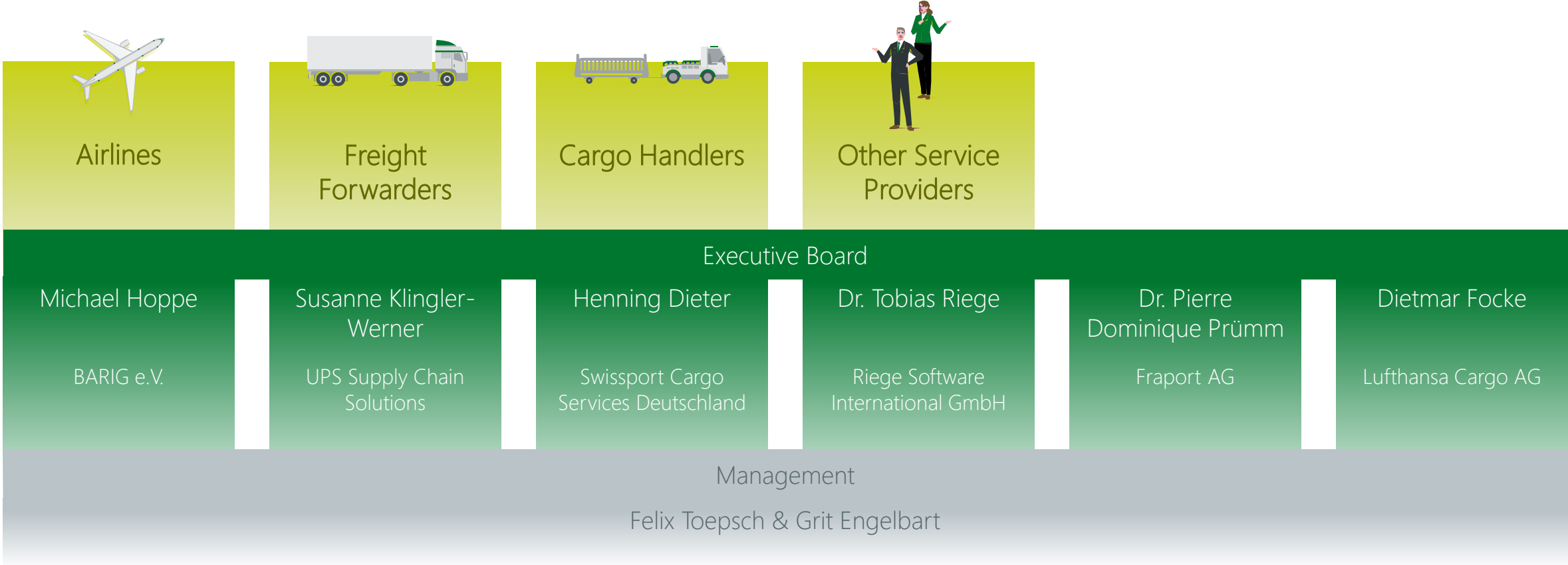

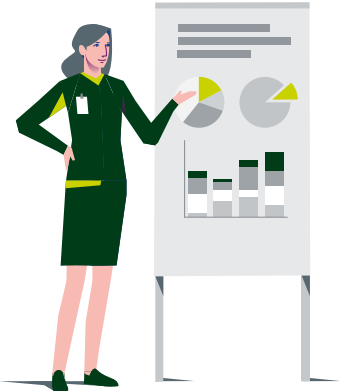

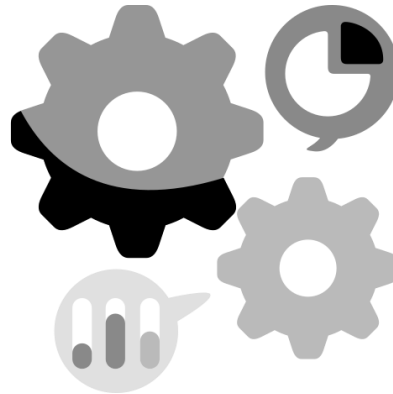
Common Pre-Check

Speedgate 2.0

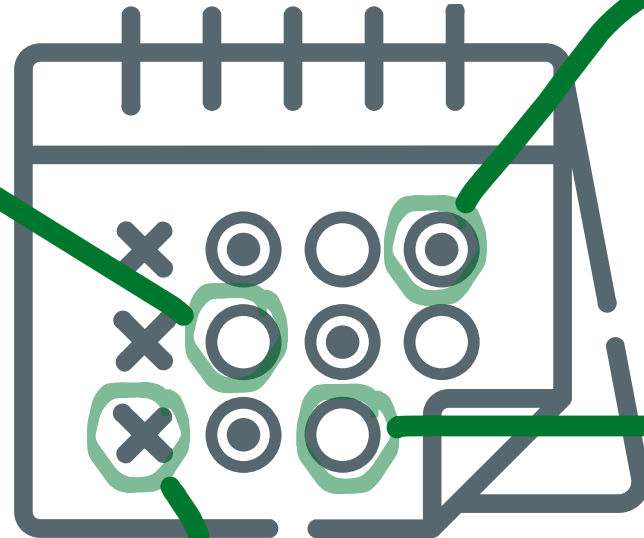

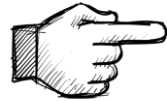
